


CARTAYNA GSX Level 2 CONFIGURATION FILES

LEPA - Palma de Mallorca (FSX-P3DV4) - JustSim



Palma de Mallorca Airport (Catalan: Aeroport de Palma de Mallorca, Spanish: Aeropuerto de Palma de Mallorca; IATA: PMI, ICAO: LEPA; also known as Son Sant Joan Airport or Aeroport de Son Sant Joan) is an international airport located 8 km (5.0 mi) east of Palma, Majorca, Spain, adjacent to the village of Can Pastilla. The airport on the Balearic Islands is Spain's third largest airport after Madrid-Barajas and Barcelona-El Prat. Palma de Mallorca was used by 27.9 million passengers in 2017. The airport is the main base for the Spanish carrier Air Europa and also a focus airport for Ryanair, EasyJet, Vueling and Jet2.com. The airport shares runways with the nearby Son Sant Joan Air Force Base, operated by the Spanish Air Force. Following a decline in passenger numbers at the airport following the September 11 attacks in 2001, numbers rose steadily between 2002 and 2007 when traffic peaked at 23.2 million passengers, however from 2007 there has been a decline in passenger numbers with 21.1 million using the airport in 2010. Today, Palma de Mallorca airport carries over 29.7 million passengers to their destinations, with 178,253 aircraft movements, mostly to mainland Spain, Germany and the United Kingdom. In November 2015, Air Berlin (1978 - 2017) announced that it would shut down its hub operations at the airport which it had maintained for over ten years. All seven domestic connection routes to the mainland - such as flights to Valencia, Bilbao and Sevilla - as well as the route to Faro in Portugal ceased during spring 2016. During the Summer months the dual-runway airport handles as many movements as London-Gatwick, and on the busiest day of the week as much as 1,100 movements - almost as many as London-Heathrow, the busiest in Europe. According to the operational data provided by AENA, the airport can handle 66 movements per hour or during a 24-hour operational period, almost 1,600 aircraft movements.

 - METAL, using the best choice of jetways to match the real-life Airport configuration.
 - With Default jetways. If you wish to use the Fly Tampa jetways and profit from the rest, don't do step 2.
- ✓ Pushbacks checked for all parking's. Facing N,S, etc. added on each pushback. Also Nose Right (NR) & (NL) for the less experienced pilots!
 - ✓ All vehicles placed in a suitable position.
 - ✓ Parking list
 - ✓ Dockings

HOW TO INSTALL:

FIRST: Drop the desired jetway configuration with a folder named "VIRTUALI" that is within the "Roaming-glass or metal" and drop it in the folder named **ROAMING** in your **APPDATA** folder (to find this folder, type %appdata% on your explorer).

SECOND: Do not install the Sode Pack or just turn it off with the corresponding .bat. Also you can switch it OFF by changing to ".OFF" the "FSDG_SODE_EDDW.XML" file located in the C:\ProgramData\12bPilot\SODE\xml folder.

SECOND: Set to ".OFF" the file "gates_Jepa.BGL". This will be located in the scenery folder of JustSim-LEPA P3DV4>data>Scenery

IMPORTANT NOTICE:


- ✓ There is ONLY ONE file in your C:\Users\YOU\AppData\Roaming\Virtuali\GSX that starts with the four letters of the scenery config you are importing from Cartayna Configuration files.
- ✓ Also make sure once you enter the simulator to go to the Add-on Menu > Coautl settings > Restart Coautl and rebuild airport cache. After doing this, if you don't see all the jetways, restart the Coautl 2-3 times or until ALL jetways show on the scenery.
